

Child Abuse Identification Workshop

Effective January 1, 1991 all applicants for certification are required to complete two clock hours of coursework or training regarding the identification and reporting of suspected child abuse and maltreatment in accordance with Sections 3003(4) and 3004 of the Education Law. This training is available only from a provider approved by the New York State Education Department. Upon completion of the workshop, the provider will give you a Certification of Completion. This document should be attached to your application. In the case of persons completing State registered programs leading to certification, no Certification of Completion will be awarded because the training is a required component of the programs.

School Violence Prevention and Intervention Workshop

Effective February 2, 2001 all applicants for certification are required to complete two clock hours of course work or training in school violence prevention and intervention in accordance with section 3004 of the Education Law. This training is available only from a provider approved by the New York State Education Department. Upon completion of the workshop, the provider will give you a Certification of Completion. This document should be attached to your application. In the case of persons completing State registered programs leading to certification, no Certification of Completion will be awarded because the training is a required component of the programs.
